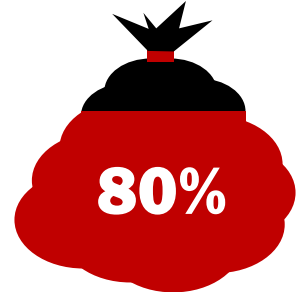


!ATTENTION PADDLERS!
